CUSTOMER WASTE DECLARATION

I declare that:

- the waste I am transporting, or intend to transport, is accurately described in all communications with REMONDIS Australia Pty Ltd. and classified in the Drivers Waste Log situated at REMONDIS Dandenong South Liquid Processing Plant;
- where I have passed the responsibility of this waste to a third-party transport company, I understand under the terms of this agreement, I can and will still be held fully responsible for the waste disposal.
- I have supplied all relevant information to the composition and safe handling of the Waste I am transporting or disposing;
- I have not added, removed, mixed, blended, diluted, or otherwise altered or tampered with the Waste in any way.

I understand that, under the Environment Protection Act 2017 (Vic) (Act):

- I have a general environmental duty to minimise the risks of harm to human health or the environment from pollution or waste, so far as reasonably practicable; and
- I have a duty to take all reasonable and practicable steps to ensure that the Waste is disposed of in a lawful way.
- Providing false or misleading information may result in the Waste being disposed of unlawfully;
- providing false or misleading information about the Waste may constitute an offence under the Act and this includes:
 - o providing false or misleading information about the type, properties and classification of the Waste; or
 - o providing false or misleading information about the risks to human health or the environment from the Waste; or
 - o concealing information or documents about the type, properties and classification of the Waste; or
 - o concealing information or documents about the risks to human health or the environment from the Waste; and
- if I fail to comply with the requirements imposed on me by the Act, I may be subject to enforcement action by the regulator and if found guilty of providing false or misleading information about the waste or Waste Sample, may be liable for a fine and/or imprisonment.

I also understand that REMONDIS may refuse to receive any subsequent Waste or adjust the disposal cost of the material if they believe that it is not reflective of the reasonable expectations of this waste type or as sampled.
