- ✗ Polystyrene
- ✗ Tissues

Did you know?

Cardboard can be easily and effectively recycled, which can prevent the release of methane from cardboard in landfills, save trees, and reduce water and energy use.

Remember: Flatten your cardboard boxes before placing them in the bin to save space and create additional capacity for recycling more items.
